1. The Fjord Horse must be NFHR registered, DNA tested & micro-chipped.

- 2. The owner of the fjord must be a member in good standing with the NFHR.
- 3. A completed Entry Form and appropriate fees must be sent to the Registrar prior to the <u>deadline</u> <u>stated on the entry form</u>. If your horse is entered in both the Introductory and Advanced tests, and fails to qualify for the Advanced, the entry fee for the advance test will be refunded.

NOTES AND RULES

INDEMNITY

The Lincoln County Parks & Rec. Employees or PNFPG and its officials will not be held responsible for any claims resulting from injury, loss, accident, illness, disease, action or inaction.

Access to grounds:

Access to the grounds will be available starting on Monday Sept 9th. Stall assignments will be posted on the Ad/Information Board which is placed about two thirds of the way in. PLEASE DON'T MOVE YOUR HORSES FROM THE ASSIGNED STALLS WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE ORGANIZERS OR LINCOLN COUNTY PARKS & REC.

• Camper spaces:

• Camper spaces are available on a first come bases. There will be specific spaces set aside for the organizers of the Libby Show and for the larger rigs that are bringing 4 ups, please check the map on the information board. Smaller rigs and campers can camp on the left side of the road into the show grounds. There is a \$5.00 per day charge for camping on the grounds. Showers are available.

• Stalls:

- There are 3 types of stalls available; Regular back to back stalls (maximum 2 horses per stall). Individual stalls (separated by a space all around) and Stallion pens which are partially covered. There will be a flat \$25.00 fee for stalls for the duration of the Evaluation. For those of you that are staying for the Libby International Fjord show there will be a separate stall reservation form in the show packets for that show.
- There will be sawdust for bedding your stalls, if you wish straw you can bring your own or purchase it from the local Feed store

• Coggins Reports:

- The owner must mail a copy of a current (within 12 months) negative coggins report to the NFHR for each horse.
- The coggins result will be presented at the gate before any horse will be permitted on fair grounds. You may be required to leave a copy of the coggins report with the guards.
- Under Montana state law, each horse must have proof of a current official negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia [Coggins], current Health Certificate, Brand Inspection and a Montana Haul permit number (your veterinarian can call the state of Montana and get this for you)

Medical Waste:

• Medical waste (needles, syringes, etc) must not be discarded in the stalls, manure pits, garbage cans, or on the grounds. These items must be placed in the appropriate containers.

Directions

- Coming from either Kalispell Montana or Bonners Ferry Idaho enter Libby on Highway 2, at California Street turn to North towards Libby Dam. Go through town and cross the river go approx half a mile, on the Right will be a wooden sign for J. Neils Memorial Park, turn to the Right and follow the road into the show grounds.
