
Stabling

From the North: It is best to come south on Hwy 2 (Deerfoot Trail) and thenWEST along Hwy 22X toward Spruce Meadows. (Marquis of Lorne Trail) Then take Hwy 2A south (Macleod Trail) toward Fort Macleod. From Hwy 2A turn west on 226 Ave (teepees on the corner) and this road curves south. Follow to 306 Ave. Turn East on 306 Ave. If stabling / camping in section A, turn into second driveway. If section B, go further east on 306 to driveway marked Ranch House.

From the South: Hwy 2 Turn West towards Okotoks at exit 209. Cross the railway tracks and turn right onto Hwy 7 at the first light. When you get to Okotoks, turn North into town and follow this road through town, across the river and tracks to lights at the Petro-Can and Fas-Gas. Turn West. Follow this road until it curves north and continue north to 306 Ave. Turn East on 306 Ave. If stabling / camping in section A, turn into second driveway. 
